
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MATERIALS & EQUIPMENT

- School-issued laptop or tablet
- Mobile phone with camera OR a digital camera (students without cameras may be accommodated on a one-on-one basis)
- Notebook or section in a binder to write notes (notes may be typed if preferred)

PROGRAMS AND APPS



- **Microsoft Teams** will be used as our main platform for communication and assignments. Students should check in on Teams daily from their laptops for class meetings and for announcements. (A mobile app is also available which makes it easier for submitting photo projects straight from your phone.)
- **OneDrive** is free cloud storage provided by our school district. I recommend saving your work here (many of you already use it).
- **Snapseed** is a free photo editing mobile app that will be used in addition to the phone's in-camera editing features.
- **PiCollage** is a free mobile app that will be used when turning in a series of photos in one collage. If you already have a collage app, that should be fine.
- **Photopea.com** is a free web based program for photo editing that resembles Adobe Photoshop. *Required for Advanced Photo, optional for Photo 1.*
- **Focos** is a free mobile app that allows manipulation of the aperture setting usually found on DSLR cameras. *Required for Advanced Photo, optional for Photo 1.*
